DPW-Superintendent Lonnie Schulz: Lonnie Schulz stated the Lagoon Spring discharge and Autokiniton spring testing will be taking place this month. Lonnie stated the weather is still below freezing so portable toilets have been placed down at Ackerman Park. The bathrooms will be opened when the weather breaks. Lonnie also stated the street sweeping and hydrant flushing will take place when the weather warms up.
