Clerk/Treasurer- Phyllis Baranski: Phyllis Baranski stated the audit went smoothly and Sara Mallory from Nietzke Faupel will present the report in August. Phyllis stated that the Summer Rec. Program has a provisional license through the State of Michigan. All policies and site inspection were completed and approved in time for Summer Rec. to start yesterday. Police-Chief Scott Jobes: Scott Jobes stated complaints are at 307 for the year compared to 313 last year at this time. Scott Jobes stated he presented Warren Kuhl with a lifesaving pin and plaque last week for his actions at Ackerman Park. Scott stated the Lion's Kids Day went good. Scott stated a digital speed sign was removed from N. Main Street by the MDOT road work sign crew without any communication from them. DPW-Superintendent Lonnie Schulz: Lonnie Schulz stated the Ackerman Park project is 97% done. The pickle ball/basketball courts will be painted by the end of June. Lonnie stated the Barbara and Mary Street projects are done other than the completion of the brush removal at the dead end/railroad track area. The street project came in under budget.

Ambulance-Coordinator Tracy Macdowall- Matt Lewis gave the report due to Tracy Macdowall being absent. Matt stated there were 22 runs in May with 6 billable, 2 lift assists, and 1 disregard.
